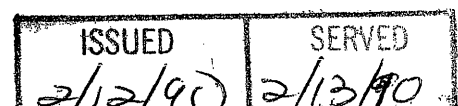
ORDER NO. 90-067-WP

FINDINGS OF FACT

Pursuant to the provisions of the Alabama Environmental Management Act, Code of Alabama 1975, §§ 22-22A-1 to 22-22A-16 (1984 and 1989 Cum. Supp.), and the Alabama Water Pollution Control Act, Code of Alabama 1975, §§ 22-22-1 to 22-22-14 (1984 and 1989 Cum. Supp.), and the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System administered by the Alabama Department of Environmental Management (hereinafter, "the Department") and approved by the Administrator of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency pursuant to the Federal Water Pollution Control Act §402, 33 U.S.C. §1342, the Department makes the following FINDINGS OF FACT:

1. On July 29, 1988, the Department issued Administrative Order Number 88-075-WP to the Water Works and Sewer Board of the City of Greenville. The object of such Order was to compel compliance with the discharge limitations contained in NPDES Permit Number AL0020532.

2. Paragraph A of Order No. 88-075-WP imposed interim discharge limitations for several pollutant parameters.



3. The interim discharge loading limitations for these pollutant parameters were derived using average monthly wastewater flows from 1987 and early 1988, which are significantly lower than current average monthly flows.

4. On June 20, 1989, the Department issued Administrative Order Number 89-092-WP to the Water Works and Sewer Board of the City of Greenville imposing new interim discharge limits.

5. Paragraph A of Administrative Order Number 89-092-WP imposed discharge limitations for ammonia and suspended solids which were determined in error.

ORDER

Based upon the foregoing FINDINGS OF FACT and pursuant to Code of Alabama 1975, §§ 22-22A-5(10), 22-22A-5(18), 22-22-9(c), 22-22-9(i) and 22-22-9(k) (1989 Cum. Supp.) and the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System administered by the Department and approved by the Administrator of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency pursuant to the Federal Water Pollution Control Act §402, 33 U.S.C. §1342, it is hereby ORDERED:

A. That the discharge limitations set out in paragraph A of Order No. 88-075-WP are hereby modified to read as follows:



B. That all other provisions set out in Order Nos. 88-075-WP and 89-092-WP not specifically modified hereby, shall remain in full force and effect.


