

#### Keywords:

(Now – Look! – Listen! – at the moment – at present)

#### Example:

- I **am playing** now.
- She **is eating** at the moment.
- Look! They **are running**.
- Listen! He **is singing**.

#### Negative:

Subject (الفاعل) + ( am / is / are ) + not + v + ing

- I am **not reading** a book.
- He is **not watching** TV.

#### Note:

- is not → isn't
- are not → aren't

#### Yes/No question:

Am, is, are + Subject + verb + ing + ?

- Is he running? Yes, he is. (or) No, he isn't.
- Are you eating? Yes, I am. (or) No, I am not.

#### Wh-question

Wh-word + am / is / are + subject + (verb + ing) + ?

- What **are** you **doing**?
- I **am** reading.


